

Strengthening the Ethical Values of the Legal Profession as a Preventive Effort Against Corruption in the Law Enforcement System from the Perspective of Anti-Corruption Education

Penguatan Nilai-Nilai Etika Profesi Hukum sebagai Upaya Pencegahan Korupsi dalam Sistem Penegakan Hukum dari Perspektif Pendidikan Anti Korupsi

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ABSTRAK

Korupsi merupakan salah satu permasalahan serius dalam sistem penegakan hukum di Indonesia yang tidak hanya merugikan keuangan negara, tetapi juga melemahkan kepercayaan masyarakat terhadap institusi hukum. Profesi advokat sebagai bagian dari aparat penegak hukum memiliki peran strategis dalam menjaga integritas dan mewujudkan keadilan yang berlandaskan etika profesi. Penelitian ini bertujuan untuk menganalisis penguatan nilai-nilai etika profesi advokat sebagai upaya preventif dalam mencegah praktik korupsi dalam perspektif pendidikan anti korupsi. Metode yang digunakan adalah penelitian kualitatif dengan pendekatan normatif melalui studi literatur terhadap peraturan perundang-undangan, kode etik advokat, serta karya ilmiah yang relevan. Hasil penelitian menunjukkan bahwa internalisasi nilai kejujuran, tanggung jawab, independensi, dan profesionalisme dalam pendidikan anti korupsi berperan penting dalam membentuk karakter advokat yang berintegritas. Pendidikan anti korupsi tidak hanya berfungsi sebagai sarana pembentukan kesadaran hukum, tetapi juga sebagai instrumen preventif dalam mencegah penyimpangan etika profesi dalam praktik penegakan hukum. Oleh karena itu, penguatan pendidikan anti korupsi berbasis etika profesi advokat menjadi langkah strategis dalam mewujudkan sistem peradilan yang bersih, transparan, dan berkeadilan.

ABSTRACT

Corruption is one of the most serious problems in Indonesia's law enforcement system, as it not only causes financial losses to the state but also weakens public trust in legal institutions. The legal profession, particularly advocates, plays a strategic role in maintaining integrity and ensuring justice based on professional ethics. This study aims to analyze

the strengthening of advocates' professional ethical values as a preventive effort to combat corruption from the perspective of anti-corruption education. The method used in this research is a qualitative approach with normative legal research through literature review of statutory regulations, advocates' code of ethics, and relevant scholarly works, including studies by Budi Sastra Panjaitan. The results show that the internalization of values such as honesty, responsibility, independence, and professionalism within anticorruption education plays an important role in shaping advocates with strong integrity. Anti-corruption education functions not only as a means of developing legal awareness but also as a preventive instrument to reduce ethical violations in law enforcement practice. Therefore, strengthening anti-corruption education based on advocates' professional ethics is a strategic step toward establishing a clean, transparent, and just judicial system.

1. INTRODUCTION

Corruption is one of the serious problems that still remains a main challenge in the law enforcement system in Indonesia. Corrupt practices not only cause financial losses to the state, but also impact the decline

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of public trust in law enforcement institutions and weaken the authority of law as an instrument of social justice. According to the 2024 Indonesia Corruption Perception Index report, Indonesia's score is 37 on a scale of 0–100, indicating that the level of corruption still constitutes a structural problem in governance and national law enforcement (Transparency International, 2024). In addition, the 2024 Anti-Corruption Behavior Index released by the Central Bureau of Statistics shows a score of 3.85, which has decreased compared to the previous year, indicating that the anti-corruption culture in society is still weak (BPS, 2024). This condition shows that eradicating corruption is not sufficient by only using an approach repressive, but also requires a preventive approach through strengthening anti-corruption education. The integrity of law enforcement officers is a major factor in realizing a fair, transparent, and accountable judicial system. Advocates, as one element of law enforcement, hold a strategic position in ensuring the supremacy of law and the protection of human rights. The profession of an advocate is known as *officium nobile*, which demands high moral and professional responsibility in carrying out their duties as law enforcers. Advocates not only act as legal advisors for clients, but also have a social responsibility in maintaining the integrity of the judicial system and ensuring the process.

Law enforcement runs in accordance with the principles of justice and legal certainty (Panjaitan, 2022). However, various challenges are still found in the implementation of the legal profession, particularly related to professional ethical violations that have the potential to create opportunities for corruption practices or other unprofessional behaviors in the law enforcement process. These professional ethical violations not only damage the image of the legal profession as *officium nobile*, but also impact the weakening of public trust in the judicial system as a whole. Therefore, strengthening the values of legal professional ethics becomes a very important need in supporting efforts to prevent corruption in the law enforcement system in Indonesia. Anti-corruption education plays a strategic role as an instrument for the formation of character and legal awareness for law enforcement officers, including lawyers. Anti-corruption education not only functions as a means of transferring knowledge about danger of corruption, but also as a process of internalizing values of integrity such as honesty, responsibility, discipline, courage, and concern for public interest. The internalization of these values is expected to be able to shape the character of professional advocates who are of integrity and committed to the enforcement of clean and fair law. In line with this, the research by Panjaitan et al. (2024) confirms that advocates play an important role in realizing access to justice as well as maintaining professionalism in the law enforcement system, particularly in strengthening the role of advocates based on legal values and professional ethics. This role This shows that advocates not only function as legal companions but also as part of the law enforcement structure that has a moral responsibility in maintaining the integrity of the judicial system. Therefore, strengthening the ethical values of the advocacy profession through the perspective of anti-corruption education becomes a strategic step in preventive efforts against corrupt practices within Indonesia's law enforcement system. Based on the above explanation, it is important to conduct this research in order to analyze the strengthening of the ethical values of the advocacy profession as a preventive measure against corruption in the law enforcement system from the perspective of anti-corruption education. This research is expected to provide an academic contribution to the development of studies in anti-corruption education and serve as a reference in efforts to strengthen the integrity of the advocacy profession as part of a clean, transparent, and fair judicial system.

Literature Review

Professional ethics is a set of values and norms that serve as guidelines in carrying out a profession responsibly and with dignity. Professional ethics play an important role as a moral foundation in performing law enforcement duties that are oriented toward justice, legal certainty, and the benefits of the law. The legal profession is known as *officium nobile* or a noble profession, so in its implementation, lawyers are required to uphold integrity, independence, and professional responsibility in providing legal assistance to the community. This shows that lawyers not only act as legal companions for clients but also as part of the judicial system.

who have a moral responsibility in upholding the supremacy of law. According to Budi Sastra Panjaitan (2024), attorneys have a strategic role in realizing access to justice as well as maintaining professionalism within the law enforcement system. This role emphasizes that attorneys are one of the essential elements within the judicial system, not only tasked with providing legal assistance but also contributing to maintaining the balance of the law enforcement process to ensure it continues in accordance with the principles of justice and legal certainty. Therefore, attorneys' integrity becomes an important factor in supporting the realization of a clean and just law enforcement system. In addition, anti-corruption education is one of the important instruments in shaping individuals with integrity, legal awareness, and high moral standards. Anti-corruption education does not only focus on providing an understanding of the negative impacts of corruption, but also emphasizes in the internalization of moral values such as honesty,

responsibility, discipline, courage, and concern for the public interest. These values become the foundation for building a legal culture oriented toward preventing corruption practices from an early age, especially within higher education and legal professions. Strengthening the ethical values of the advocate profession is closely related to preventive efforts against corruption practices. As part of law enforcement officers, advocates have the responsibility to maintain the integrity of their profession and avoid any form of deviation that could damage public trust in the judicial system. Therefore, strengthening anti-corruption education becomes a strategic step in building the professionalism of advocates based on ethical values and legal integrity. In line with this, research conducted by Budi Sastra Panjaitan (2022) emphasizes that professionalism Lawyers are not only related to technical abilities in providing legal assistance, but also related to moral responsibility in maintaining access to justice for the community. Strengthening the ethical values of the legal profession through the perspective of anti-corruption education becomes one of the important steps in supporting the realization of a law enforcement system that is transparent, accountable, and just in Indonesia. III. RESEARCH METHOD This research approach uses normative legal research with a descriptive qualitative type. Normative legal research is research conducted by reviewing primary legal materials and secondary legal materials related to the issues being studied to obtain arguments, theories, or concepts to answer the basis of the problem (Marzuki, 2019). The research in this study is focused on strengthening the ethical values of the legal profession as a preventive effort against corruption in the law enforcement system through the perspective anti-corruption education. The research approaches used in this study are the statutory approach (statute approach) and the conceptual approach (conceptual approach). The statutory approach towards the judicial system. Therefore, strengthening anti-corruption education becomes a strategic step in developing the professionalism of advocates based on the values of ethics and legal integrity. In line with this, research conducted by Budi Sastra Panjaitan (2022) confirms that the professionalism of advocates is not only related to technical ability in providing legal assistance, but also related to moral responsibility in maintaining access to justice for the public. Strengthening the ethical values of the legal profession through the perspective of anti-corruption education becomes one of the important steps in supporting the realization of a transparent, accountable, and fair law enforcement system in Indonesia.

2. METHOD

This research uses a normative legal approach with descriptive qualitative type. Normative legal research is research conducted by examining primary legal materials and secondary law related to the issues being studied to obtain arguments, theories, or concepts as answers to the basis of the problem (Marzuki, 2019). Research in this study focuses on strengthening the ethical values of the advocate profession as a preventive effort against corruption in the law enforcement system through the perspective of anti-corruption education. The research approaches used in this study are the statutory approach and the conceptual approach. The statutory approach is carried out by examining various laws and regulations related to the advocate profession and anti-corruption education, such as Law Number 18 of 2003 concerning Advocates and the provisions regarding the code of ethics for the advocate profession. Meanwhile, the conceptual approach is carried out by studying concepts related to professional ethics of advocates, integrity of law enforcers, and the values of anti-corruption education as efforts to prevent corruption practices in the law enforcement system. The data sources in this study consist of primary legal materials and secondary legal materials. The primary legal materials include legislation related to the legal profession and anti-corruption education. Meanwhile, the secondary legal materials include books, literature, scientific journals, as well as previous research results that are relevant to the research topic, including the work of Budi Sastra Panjaitan which discusses the role of lawyers in the law enforcement system and access to justice. In addition, this study also uses reports from official institutions as supporting data to strengthen the research analysis. The data collection technique in this study was conducted through library research, namely by collecting and examining various primary and secondary legal materials that are relevant to the research problem (Soekanto, 2014). The data obtained were then analyzed qualitatively. descriptive by grouping, interpreting, and connecting various relevant legal materials systematically so that a comprehensive conclusion is obtained according to the research objectives. Analysis is carried out with an emphasis on strengthening the values of professional ethics advocates as part of preventive efforts in preventing corrupt practices through an anti-corruption education approach within the law enforcement system in Indonesia.

3. RESULT AND DISCUSSION

The Role of Legal Profession Ethics for Advocates in the Law Enforcement System According to Budi Sastra Panjaitan, advocates have a strategic role in ensuring access to justice as well as maintaining balance in the law enforcement process. This role shows that advocates not only function as defenders of clients' interests but also as guardians of justice values within the legal system. Advocates are one of the crucial components in the law enforcement system with a strategic position in guaranteeing the upholding of justice and the protection of human rights. Advocates not only serve as providers of legal assistance to clients but also as part of the judicial system responsible for maintaining the integrity and professionalism of law enforcement.

The correlation between the ethical values of the advocacy profession and the values of anti-corruption education can be seen in the following table.

Based on the table above, it can be understood that the ethical values of the advocate profession are closely related to the values contained in anti-corruption education. This relationship indicates that strengthening the ethical values of advocates can become one of the preventive efforts to prevent corrupt practices within the law enforcement system. This is in line with the view of Budi Sastra Panjaitan (2024), who states that advocates, as part of the judicial system, have the responsibility to maintain professional integrity in order to support the realization of access to justice based on the principles of professionalism and legal morality.

The integrity possessed by advocates correlates with the value of honesty in anti-corruption education. Integrity serves as the main foundation for advocates in carrying out their professional duties responsibly without manipulating legal facts or abusing authority. Anti-corruption education places honesty as a fundamental value in building individuals with integrity and commitment toward clean law enforcement (KPK, 2020). Furthermore, the value of advocate independence is related to the value of responsibility in anti-corruption education. Independence demonstrates that advocates must be able to carry out their profession freely without intervention from any party, whether clients or other interested parties. The independence of the advocate profession is an essential requirement in maintaining the objectivity of the law enforcement process, as emphasized in Law Number 18 of 2003 concerning Advocates.

The value of advocate professionalism also has a close relationship with the value of discipline in anti-corruption education. Professionalism is reflected in the advocate's ability to perform duties in accordance with legal provisions and the applicable professional code of ethics. Such professionalism is part of the advocate's responsibility in maintaining the quality of legal services for society and preventing deviations in law enforcement practices (Budi Sastra Panjaitan, 2022).

In addition, advocate loyalty to the law is associated with the value of concern for public interest. Advocates are not only responsible to their clients but also carry a moral responsibility toward upholding justice in society. This is consistent with the opinion of Soerjono Soekanto (2014), who stated that the legal profession has a social function in maintaining order and justice within society. The value of advocate accountability is related to the value of transparency in anti-corruption education. Accountability indicates that every action taken by advocates must be legally and morally accountable. Transparency is one of the important

principles in creating a clean law enforcement system and increasing public trust in judicial institutions (Marzuki, 2019). The moral values of the advocate profession are associated with the value of courage in anti-corruption education. Courage is required for advocates to reject all forms of corruption, bribery, and intervention that may damage professional integrity. Anti-corruption education emphasizes the importance of moral courage as part of preventive efforts in building a legal culture with integrity (KPK, 2020).

Anti-Corruption Education as a Preventive Effort in the Law Enforcement System

Corruption is one of the most serious problems that can hinder the realization of a fair, transparent, and accountable law enforcement system. Corrupt practices not only cause economic losses to the state, but also lead to a decline in public trust in law enforcement institutions. Therefore, systematic and sustainable preventive efforts are required through an anti-corruption education approach as part of the national strategy for corruption prevention.

Anti-corruption education plays an important role in shaping individuals with integrity and a high level of legal awareness regarding the dangers of corruption in national and state life (KPK, 2020). Anti-corruption education is a learning process aimed at instilling the values of honesty, responsibility, discipline, courage, concern, and commitment to public interests as the foundation for building anti-corruption behavior. These values serve as the main foundation in developing a legal culture oriented toward preventing corrupt practices from an early stage, particularly within higher education institutions, including legal education. This is in line with the view that education has a strategic role in building public legal awareness as part of efforts to create an effective and just legal system (Soerjono Soekanto, 2014).

Anti-corruption education has become an important instrument in strengthening the integrity of law enforcement officials, including advocates as one of the essential elements within the judicial system. Advocates, as a profession known as *officium nobile*, have a moral responsibility to maintain professionalism and integrity in carrying out their duties. Therefore, the internalization of anti-corruption education values within the legal profession is a strategic step in preventing legal misconduct that may lead to corrupt practices. This is consistent with the opinion of Budi Sastra Panjaitan (2024), who states that the professionalism of advocates is closely related to moral commitment in maintaining access to justice and supporting the supremacy of law.

The role of anti-corruption education as a preventive effort within the law enforcement system can be seen in the following table

Based on the table above, it can be understood that anti-corruption education has a strategic role as a preventive effort in strengthening the integrity of law enforcement officers, particularly advocates as part of the judicial system. Values such as honesty, responsibility, discipline, social awareness, and moral courage serve as the foundation for shaping a professional character that has integrity and is able to reject legal deviations. The internalization of these values is important in creating a legal enforcement system that is transparent, accountable, and oriented toward the public interest (KPK, 2020; Soerjono Soekanto, 2014). In addition, values such as justice, simplicity, and independence also play a role in maintaining the independence of advocates from external intervention and preventing conflicts of interest in legal practice. Strengthening these values through anti-corruption education can improve the professionalism of advocates while also supporting the realization of access to justice within the judicial system. This is in line with the view of Budi Sastra Panjaitan (2024), who emphasizes that the professionalism of advocates is not only determined by technical ability, but also by moral commitment in maintaining integrity and the supremacy of law in society.

Furthermore, anti-corruption education also functions as a means of forming an integrity-based legal culture through strengthening professional ethical values within the law enforcement system. The integration of anti-corruption education into higher legal education curricula is one of the effective preventive steps in shaping prospective law enforcement officers who have ethical awareness and social responsibility. A preventive approach through education is considered more effective than a repressive approach because it is able to build legal awareness from an early stage and form individual character oriented toward values of honesty and responsibility (KPK, 2020).

Strengthening anti-corruption education in the legal enforcement system can also be carried out through improving the quality of legal professional education, internalizing professional codes of ethics, and continuous supervision of professional practice. These efforts are expected to form law enforcement officers who not only have professional competence but also possess high moral integrity in carrying out their duties. Anti-corruption education has a strategic role as a preventive effort in creating a clean, transparent, and just legal system in Indonesia (Marzuki, 2019).

Strengthening the Ethical Values of the Advocate Profession in the Perspective of Anti-Corruption Education

The strengthening of ethical values in the advocate profession from the perspective of anti-corruption education is a strategic step in building an integrity-based and just legal enforcement system. As a profession known as **officium nobile**, advocates have a moral responsibility to uphold honesty, independence, professionalism, and accountability in carrying out their duties as part of the judicial system. Anti-corruption education plays an important role in this regard in shaping the character of advocates who are oriented towards the value of integrity and high legal awareness. This is in line with the view of Soerjono Soekanto (2014) who stated that legal awareness and the integrity of law enforcement officers are important factors in determining the success of law enforcement in society. Strengthening the ethical values

of the legal profession can also be carried out through the integration of anti-corruption higher education in law or continuous professional advocate education. This integration aims to shape the ethical awareness of prospective advocates from an early stage so that they are able to carry out their profession professionally and responsibly. Anti-corruption education is part of a preventive strategy that emphasizes character building through the internalization of values such as honesty, responsibility, discipline, and courage in professional life. The Corruption Eradication Commission affirms that anti-corruption education aims to instill values Integrity as a preventive measure against corruption practices from an early stage (KPK, 2020).

4. CONCLUSION

Based on the discussion, it can be concluded that the ethical values of the advocate profession play a crucial role in supporting the realization of a law enforcement system that is integrity-based, transparent, and just. As part of law enforcement officials known as *officium nobile*, advocates are required to uphold the values of integrity, independence, professionalism, and responsibility in carrying out their duties.

Strengthening the ethical values of the advocate profession is a strategic step in preventing legal deviations that have the potential to lead to acts of corruption within the justice system. This is in line with the view of Budi Sastra Panjaitan (2024), who emphasizes that advocate professionalism plays an important role in maintaining the balance of the justice system and supporting the realization of access to justice for society.

In addition, anti-corruption education has a strategic role as a preventive effort in shaping the character of advocates with integrity through the internalization of values such as responsibility, honesty, discipline, care, courage, independence, and fairness in legal professional practice. The integration of anti-corruption education values into legal higher education and advocate professional training is an important step in strengthening ethical awareness among law enforcement officers from an early stage.

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
